All students enrolled on Hairdressing, Beauty Therapy, Make-up Artistry or Fashion Make-up courses are required to participate as both participants (models) and practitioners in all practical skills training relevant to the course. If you believe that participation as a model may be problematic for you for reasons of religion, gender or health, you should discuss your concerns before enrolling on the course. Participation as a practitioner in all practical skills elements is mandatory to pass the course.

HND BEAUTY THERAPY

AHBHNDBEAU

SCQF level 8

Full time – Duration 2 years

EDUCATION PROGRESSION

Students may wish to progress to university level courses in Complementary Therapies.

CAREER PROGRESSION

Successful students may find employment in: salons and clinics; sports centres and health clubs; ocean liners and airlines; retail management; lecturing and assessing. Some of our previous students have successfully opened their own business.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum of one Higher, preferably English or
- SVQ Beauty Therapy Level 3
- Entry to the course will be dependent on the successful outcome of interview
- Recommended minimum age 17 years. Maturity of approach is essential
- Students must be prepared to communicate and work with members of the public and to practise their skills within the peer group.

COURSE CONTENT

There is a high level of self directed study and students are required to undertake work experience as part of the course. Students are required to practise treatments on members of the public throughout the course.

Core units include:

- Management and practices of facial and body therapies
- Anatomy and physiology of the human body
- Employment experiences 1 and 2
- Contemporary electrotherapy
- Product knowledge
- Electro cosmetic therapy

- Lifestyle advice for clients
- Preparing and presenting a business plan
- Principles and practices of selling
- Graded units 1 and 2

Optional units may include:

- Hand and foot treatments
- Depilation
- Contemporary aesthetic treatments
- Electrical epilation
- Body massage
- Facial treatments
- Spa therapies
- Make-up for special occasions

SVQ BEAUTY THERAPY Level 3 (Massage)

AHBSVQ3BTH

SCQF Level 6/7

Full time – Duration 1 year

EDUCATION PROGRESSION

Students who successfully complete the course may then progress to HNC/HND Beauty Therapy or to Complementary Therapies courses.

CAREER PROGRESSION

Opportunities for employment in beauty salons, airlines, health spas, cruise liners.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- It is essential to have good communication skills and be able to work with members of the general public and practise their skills within the peer group
- SVQ Beauty Therapy Level 2 or
- NCGA Level 5 Beauty Therapy
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview.

COURSE CONTENT

Core units may include:

- Provide body massage
- Provide self-tanning services
- Massage using aromatherapy oils
- Stone therapy treatments
- Facial electrical treatments
- Plan and promote promotional activities
- Health and safety - supervisory
- Additional units may be self-financed or ILA funded

SVQ BEAUTY THERAPY Level 2 (General)

AHBSVQ2BTH

SCQF Level 5

Full time – Duration one year

EDUCATION PROGRESSION

SVQ Level 3 Beauty Therapy General or Massage, HND Beauty Therapy

CAREER PROGRESSION

Successful students may find employment in a variety of areas in the expanding beauty industry eg nail technician, salon receptionist and skin care consultant.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 16 years old before 1 October
- A minimum of three Standard Grades at Grade 3 or above incl English
- Successful completion of SVQ Level 1 Beauty Therapy or NPA equivalent.
- It is essential to have excellent communication skills and to be able to work effectively with members of the general public and practise their skills within the peer group.
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview

COURSE CONTENT

This course provides a broad range of therapy knowledge, which is suitable for both school leavers and mature applicants.

Core units include:

- Ensure your actions reduce risk to health and safety
- Promote additional products and services to clients
- Develop and maintain effectiveness at work
- Improve and maintain facial skin condition
- Provide eyelash and eyebrow treatments
- Carry out waxing service
- Provide manicure service
- Provide pedicure service
- Provide make-up service

Optional units may include:

- Nail art
- Additional units may be self-financed or ILA funded

Full time January – June

SCQF Level 4

EDUCATION PROGRESSION

SVQ Beauty Therapy Level 2

CAREER PROGRESSION

Retail therapy opportunities

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must be 16 years old by 28 February
- It is essential to have excellent communication skills and be able to work effectively with members of the general public
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview

COURSE CONTENT

This course consists of 3 NPAs that dovetail to form a full time course.

NPA Beauty and Digital Communication

Core units include:

- Beauty skills: an introduction
- Basic information and communication technology
- Personal development: self and society

NPA Creative Facial Techniques & Digital Media

Core units include:

- Skincare routine
- Contemporary make-up

NPA Creative Beauty & Digital Media

Core units include:

- Combined practical skills
- Create and present an image using beauty techniques
- Personal development - practical abilities

Option units may include:

- Anatomy
- Creative nail techniques
- Lower leg waxing

HAND & FOOT TREATMENTS

AHBHNUHAND

SCQF Level 6

Evening - Duration 18 sessions x 2 hours

COURSE OUTLINE

Single credit Higher National Unit. This unit comprises theoretical knowledge and practical applications of hand and foot treatments. Students will be expected to practise treatments on members of the public within the College salons. A level of self-directed study is required. Students will be required to wear a uniform and purchase a kit and textbook.

ARTIFICIAL NAIL EXTENSIONS

Evening - Duration 12 sessions X 3 hours
