Participation as a practitioner in all practical skills elements is mandatory to pass the course.

## **HND MAKE-UP ARTISTRY**

### **AHAHNDMKAR**

SCQF Level 8

Full time – Duration 2 years

### **EDUCATION PROGRESSION**

Access to a university degree programme.

### **CAREER PROGRESSION**

Careers in television, theatre, film, fashion and photography as a make-up artist.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- Candidates must be over 18 years of age
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview
- Skills test for all candidates at interview
- Candidates will be required to gain work experience out with college hours

#### **Entry to Year 1**

- Minimum of 1 Higher or
- Media Make-up SCQF Level 6, SCQF Level 6 Hairdressing, SVQ Level 3 Hairdressing or Beauty or relevant industrial experience.

#### **Entry to Year 2**

- HNC Hairdressing or HNC Fashion Make-up or relevant industrial experience.

Successful students may find employment as: senior stylist; salon supervisor/manager; trainer; manufacturer's technician; sales representative; self-employment

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

A minimum of three years' industrial experience (employers' references will be required) plus

- SVQ Level 3 Hairdressing or
- SCQF Level 6 Hairdressing or
- Appropriate NQ Hairdressing units or
- NPA in Technical Skills & Creative Hairdressing

- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview
- Skills test for all candidates at interview
- A minimum of 1 Higher would be preferred

- Relevant industrial experience.
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview.
- Skills test for all candidates at interview.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- SVQ Level 2 Hairdressing or
- NCGA Hairdressing Level 5 or
- NPA in Technical Skills and Creative Hairdressing
- Relevant industrial experience.
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview.
- Skills test for all candidates at interview.

### **COURSE CONTENT**

This course provides students with a high level of practical fashion work to enhance their hairdressing skills. Candidates will be required to gain work experience as part of this course.

## **NCGA HAIRDRESSING Level 5**

**AHASCQF5HR**

SCQF Level 5

Full-time - Duration one year / Part-time: two years

## **EDUCATION PROGRESSION**

Successful students may progress to SCQF Level 6 Hairdressing

## **CAREER PROGRESSION**

Salon work; junior stylist

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- Minimum age: candidates must be 16 years of age at the beginning of the programme
- Excellent communication skills and ability to work effectively with members of the general public
- An enthusiastic and motivated person with creative ability would have an advantage.
- NPA in Cosmetology would be an advantage
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview
- Skills test for all candidates at interview

## **COURSE CONTENT**

This course provides students with the minimum level of basic skills with a view to operating as a hairdresser. The course is assessed under workplace conditions, and therefore there is a strong practical element involved within the achievement of the award.

- Shampooing
- Conditioning & scalp massage
- Blow drying techniques
- Setting & winding techniques
- Ladies hairdressing
- Basic cutting
- Mix, apply and remove hair colour

### **Introduction to Hairdressing and Make-up Artistry**

Full time - Duration 22 weeks

### **CAREER PROGRESSION**

Salon assistant / trainee hairdresser / beauty therapist.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- It is essential to have excellent communication skills and be able to work effectively with members of the general public
- Entry to this course is based on successful performance at interview
