Procurement Update

Overview

At present, the College has a contract with APUC for a 0.5FTE procurement professional (Supply Chain Manager). With the additional work identified, including a review of all contracts, this was extended temporarily to 0.8FTE.

The Supply Chain Manager is currently working towards refreshing all the procurement procedures, processes and templates and will be delivering training to all staff in due course. She has been working with the IT department to establish a Procurement hub on the College portal, with access available to all staff.

A schedule of contracts coming to an end has been produced and prioritised. APUC have provided additional assistance to the College to assist and a review of the current workload and resource available is being undertaken.

Procurement Reporting

The Annual Report is currently being prepared for 01 August $20 - 31^{st}$ July 2021 and will be presented to the May 2022 meeting of the Finance and Resources Committee.

Scottish Funding Council Grants and Investment

SFC provide an allocation of ring-fenced Estates funding annually, which the College generally applies to minor works and major repairs projects. The College itself is in the throes of establishing a Strategic Investment Fund from its own resources to support change and this Fund will be synchronised to requirements. It is the intention to invest this Fund over the two to three year period, adding to it if resources become available.

Additionally, the College received an allocation of £141k in this financial year to address digital exclusion to support students who are struggling to afford to buy, maintain and connect the equipment they need to benefit from digital learning. This latter resource, has been made available by the Scottish Government and is part of the additional support for Scotland's colleges and universities in their fight against the effects of Covid-19.

Sustainability/ Carbon Reduction

Sustainability continues to be a key focus in Procurement and opportunities to build sustainability into each contract will continue to be considered. Procurement will also ensure that we build carbon reduction into the tendering exercise as it is important to adjust the working practices to enable us to reduce the carbon footprint and also have targets for reducing indirect emissions of greenhouse gases and to report on how we will align spending and use of resources with emissions reduction efforts.

The Supply Chain Manager attends the Sustainability Group to obtain information on anything that could be included in future procurement activities and to advise on opportunities for Community Benefit. Part of the improvements in process being introduced is a register of community benefits which the Supply Chain Manager will monitor and report upon.

Procurement Update

Policies and Procedures & SLC Procurement Toolkit

As part of a wider College exercise, Procurement is currently reviewing all policies and procedures and giving them a refresh. These will be loaded to a centralised data hub as an SLC Procurement Toolkit. Procurement will provide further information i.e., the GO Live date in the next report. There will be full training on the use of the Toolkit for all relevant staff.

The Procurement Toolkit will be a portal that holds all policy, procedures, and guidance for procurement activities. This includes – Thresholds for procurement, Maps of the Process, Procurement Templates, and Process guidance, this will provide all the tools required to procure compliantly.

This will also link to the SLC Contract register and APUC Framework Agreement Library; this will enable all staff to locate Framework Agreements that are available to assist within their field of expertise.
