Who we may share data with

The College uses EventBrite UK to collect your registration information. You can access their privacy notice <u>here</u>.

Retention of data

The College will retain your personal information as detailed below:

- Information on your registration to attend 30 days from the date of the College Open Event.
- Survey feedback 3 months from the date the survey is submitted.
- Direct marketing communications your data will be held for 2 years.

Your Rights

- Right of access to copies of your personal data (subject access request)
- Right to rectification if personal data we hold about you is incorrect.
- Right to deny use of personal information in local press
- Right to restrict processing of your personal data
- Right to object to our processing of your personal data
- Right to complain to the Information Commissioner's Office about how we handle your data.
